



Presentations

For this project you are to complete a presentation on a topic, controversy, or emerging research in Psychology. You may work individually or with ONE other person.

Your Presentation must include the following:

- Oral presentation (5-8 minutes, addressing the research questions)
- Visual component (PowerPoint, Posterboard, or other visual media)
- Written Component (Numbered list answering the research questions - typed)
- Peer Evaluations – must have 6 total (Due in one packet at the end of presentations.)

Research Questions

1. State your topic
2. Cite your sources (Must be at least 5)
3. Discuss the topic (Background, what you learned, dazzle and amaze us...)
4. What is the significance of the topic -- why is this subject a problem or important, practical applications?
5. Conclusions from your research -- Definite answers found? Any suggestions to gain further insight? Questions that remain?
6. *** For written portion only** Give a personal statement of your thoughts, bias, feelings towards the subject or problem prior to research. (One from each if working with a partner.)
