

The final projects for AP Art History include 8 assignments. **It is up to you to determine how many projects you want to complete.** Look at your percentage in the class, and make a decision based where you would like to be. (However, there are limits to this.)

- All students **must** complete 4 projects from the following break-down:
Project A and B, one from C, one from D.
- To raise your grade 1 percentage point, complete 6 projects.
Project A and B, one from C, one from D, and two others from C-E
- To raise your grade 2 percentage points, complete all 8 projects.
- Failure to complete the mandated 4 projects will result in a 10-point drop in your grade.

Detailed instructions for each project will be handed out for each assignment. All assignments are Pass or Fail. **NO LATE ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
