1	<b>Psychology Today</b> Review an article related to the field. Must be current.	<b>Tues. 5/21</b>
2	<b>Presentation</b> (A <u>mandatory</u> project) Choose a topic from the approved list (or with prior approval) and work alone or with a partner. Will include a short written component, a visual component, and an oral presentation.	<b>Sign Ups</b>
3	<b>Treatment</b> Research treatment facility in California.	<b>Thurs. 5/23</b>
4	<b>Psychology in Design</b> Visual/Artistic representation of a psychological concept, or an examination of psychological concepts in advertising/marketing.	<b>Wed. 5/29</b>
5	<b>Behavior Modification</b> Track excessive behaviors (e.g. cell phone use) and design/implement a plan to adjust the bx using the principles of operant conditioning.	<b>Thurs. 5/30</b>
